- **30 Credits**
 - 18 compulsory + 12 elective
- **40 Community Service Hours**
 - must be documented through Guidance office
- **Literacy Requirement**
 - Successful completion of the Ontario Secondary School
 - Literacy Test (OSSLT), or the Ontario Literacy Course (OLC)

Guide to Commencement

- **Centennial Hall, 550 Wellington Street, on Friday June 7, 2024, 5pm – 7pm.**
- This is a “**social graduation**” for all students who started secondary school in the **2020-2021** school year.
- Even if you are returning for a victory lap or if you will not meet graduation requirements by the end of June 2024, you still walk across the stage on JUNE 7 this school year, not next year.



Guide to Commencement

Time

- Doors will open at **3:30pm**.
- Check in to pick up your cap and stroll in the basement of Centennial Hall.
- There will be an area decorated in the basement of Centennial hall for you and your family to take photos. If you would like to take photos, please consider arriving at 3:30pm as we would like students to start organizing in alpha order at around 4pm.

Seating

- Seating on main floor and balcony, no limit on the number of guests per graduate but seating is first-come, first-served.

Parking

- Meter parking is available around Victoria Park, or paid parking at Citi Plaza, City Hall, and the Centennial Hall lot.

Arrival

- Arrive at around **3:30pm** to get into your gown and take photos.
- Staff will be organizing students, in alpha order in the **basement**.

Processional

- At around 5pm, you will be guided into the hall in a single file line and seated in the middle of the front.
- **It is important that you maintain your alphabetical order.**

Crossing the Stage

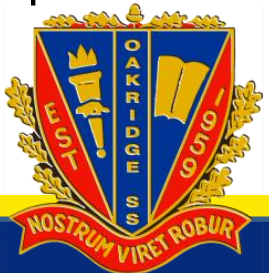
- When told to do so, by Mr. Kunder and Ms. Wales, rise with your row, quietly move to the north hallway and line up at the staircase to the stage, remain in alpha order.
- Your name card will be given to you at this time.



Guide to Commencement

Crossing the Stage (cont'd)

- When given the signal to go (Dr. Gilbert), walk to the centre of the stage, to the two presenters standing.
- Pause and shake each presenter's hand (if you feel comfortable to do so), pick up your ceremonial diploma and souvenir pin.
 - Please indicate you would like to shake hands by extending your right hand as you approach the presenters, OR
 - If you would prefer not to shake the presenters' hand, please place your right hand across your chest



Guide to Commencement

Crossing the Stage (cont'd)

- Remain on the red carpet, at centre stage, next to the staff presenting your diploma, until the teacher at the reader table is finished reading your name card.
- **If your name card is yellow, you will need to remain at the centre of the stage even longer because after the name reader is finished reading your name card Mr. Booker will announce the Commencement Award that you have been nominated for or that you will receive.**



Guide to Commencement

Diploma

- You will be handed a ceremonial diploma, along with a graduation gift, when you walk across the stage at Centennial Hall.
- If you will meet all graduation requirements by the end of June 2024, your official diploma will be available for pick up, at Oakridge, in the first week of July 2024.
- If you are an **international student** and will be graduating this year and will be **leaving London before the end of the first week of July**, please see Ms. Fiest or Ms. Rhee in the Guidance office with instructions on how to have your official diploma and transcript mailed to you.



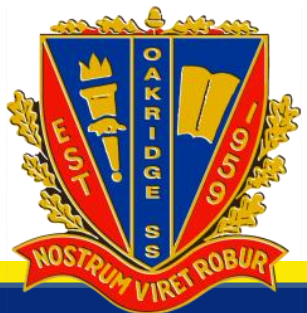

Caps and Gown Fee

- Most of you have already purchased your caps and gowns (\$25)
- See Ms. Davis Foster in the principal's office IMMEDIATELY, following this assembly, if you have not yet paid this fee.
- Secondary fee of \$25, for venue and various supplies.

Gown Pickup

- Gowns will be handed out in the **auditorium** at Oakridge by Ms. Davis Foster on **Wednesday June 5** over **lunch** and during **period 4**
- Students are responsible to ensure they bring their gown on the night of commencement



Guide to Commencement

Dressing for the Occasion

- Footwear and lower legs are visible
- Gentlemen: do not wear suit coats under the gown (too hot)
- Leave "stuff" (purses, umbrellas, etc.) with your parents/guardians. We will not look after your personal belongings.



Important Info for Grads

Rented Stoll

- Following commencement, you will have 20 minutes to take photos outside with family before you must sign off that you have returned your stoll.

Name Card

- When you walk across the stage our readers will read your name and a brief message of your plan for next year, written by you in the third person.
- Example:

John Smith

John will be attending the University of Ottawa in the fall to study political science.
