GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

1. 30 Credits
2. Volunteer Hours
 - 40 hours if you will **NOT** meet the other two OSSD requirements by the end of June 2022
3. Successful completion of the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test (OSSLT) if you will **NOT** meet the other two OSSD requirements by the end of June 2022

OSSLT

What if I have not successfully completed the OSSLT and I am currently in my grade 12 year?

1. If you will meet the other two graduation requirements (30 credits earned and 20 community service hours) by the end of June 2022, **you will be exempt from the OSSLT requirement.**
2. If you will not meet the other two graduation requirements (30 credits earned and 20 community service hours) by the end of June 2022, **you should register for the Ontario Literacy course (OLC401)** to satisfy the OSSLT requirement.

RESEARCHING ONTARIO COLLEGES

What are the prerequisite courses for the College program(s) that I would like to apply to?

1. Go to ontariocolleges.ca
2. Select the "Colleges" tab at the top-right of the page, you will find a list of 27 Colleges.
3. After you've selected a College of interest, scroll to the bottom of the page where you can filter your search by various categories to select a program
4. Click the "Website" link at the top row of the program you are interested in
5. Find the "Admissions" or "Admission Requirements" tab on the page to find the prerequisite(s) of your choice.

NEW GRADE 12 COURSE FOR 2022/2023: **CHI4U1**

Canada: History, Identity, and Culture, Grade 12 University

The focus of this course will be on **deconstructing anti-black racism in the Canadian and North American context.**

Prerequisite: Any university or university/college preparation course in Canadian and World Studies (Geography and History), English, or Social Sciences and Humanities.

MYBLUEPRINT REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Log into: **myblueprint.ca/tvdsb**
- Username: first 4 letters of last name, first 4 letter of first name, last 3 digits of student number @ **gotvdsb.ca**
 - **Example: John Smith with student number 123.456.789: smitjohn789@gotvdsb.ca**
- Password: use your “gotvdsb.ca” account password used to log into your school computer.

2022-2023 COURSE SELECTION SHEET

If you are not returning in 2022/2023,
you must:

- go to your myBlueprint account and click the **Not returning next year?** link.
Choose one of the five following destinations: Apprenticeship, College, University, Workplace, New School.
There is a brief exit survey to complete.

2022-2023 COURSE SELECTION SHEET

If you are returning for one semester only in 2022/2023, you must select the following course option, located in **Unlisted Courses** in myBlueprint. This must be done in addition to your requested Oakridge courses:

- **SEMONE** for semester one only
- **SEMTWO** for semester two only

NEXT STEPS

- Summer School and myBlueprint:
 - If you plan on taking a summer school course DO NOT register for this course in myBlueprint.
 - In the “**Student Comment**” section of the registration/confirmation page in myBlueprint, let your counsellor know what course you will register for in summer school.
 - If you are not sure about summer school, register for the course at Oakridge for next year.

EMAIL PARENT/GUARDIAN APPROVAL

After students submit their course selections in myBlueprint, they must click the [blue](#) “SEND APPROVAL EMAIL” button to a parent/guardian to approve their course selections.
