PREREQUISITES

- Always ensure you have earned (or will earn) the proper prerequisite course when selecting your courses for next year.
- For example, you must have earned (or will earn) MTH1W1 before you can take MPM2P1 or MPM2D1.

IMPORTANT NOTE TO PREPARATORY IB STUDENTS!!!!

In addition to the 6 compulsory credits listed in the previous slide, you are responsible to ensure you have earned a minimum of one compulsory credit in both the Arts (Dance, Drama, Music, Visual Arts) and Phys. Ed. by the end of your grade 10 year.

CORE ENRICHMENT CLASSES

- In grade 10, students have the choice to take the following enrichment classes: ENG2DE, MPM2DE, SNC2DE, CHC2DE.
 - You can select 1, 2, 3, or all 4 of the enriched courses offered.
 - Students will earn an academic credit. Enrichment activities are added to enhance the learning experience.

OPTIONAL COURSES

- **Optional Courses**: courses selected in addition to your 5 compulsory courses (English, Math, Science, History, Civics/Careers) to create a complete timetable (complete timetable = 8 courses).
- **Note**: an “optional course” may count toward a compulsory credit (18 in required in total), or an elective credit (12 in total).
- You will need to select 3 optional courses.

REPERTOIRE BAND/CHOIR

- Grade 10 students can earn an additional 0.5 credit by taking Repertoire Band (AMR20C) and an additional 0.5 credit by taking Repertoire Choir (AMR20W). Students may select only Band or only Choir or may choose to select both.
- These credits are in addition to the 8 credits that students must take in grade 10 and will be scheduled either before or after school, twice per week, for the entire school year (September to June).

ALTERNATE COURSES

- Sometimes a scheduling conflict may occur and a student cannot be scheduled into one or more of their optional course selections.
- **Alternate Optional Courses**: you **MUST** select 2 additional optional courses in the event that an optional course(s) is cancelled or cannot be scheduled due to a timetabling conflict.

FULL TIMETABLE

5 Compulsory Courses + 3 Optional Courses = 8 Courses (full timetable)

In myBlueprint you will select:

- 5 Compulsory courses (Eng, Math, Sci, His, Civics/Careers)
- 3 Optional courses **AND**
- 2 **Alternate** Optional courses

Note: Since Civics (CHV205) and Careers (GLC205) are 2 half credits, you will actually make 9 course selections in myBlueprint

2022-2023 COURSE SELECTION REMINDERS

- Course Selections:
 - 8 courses – Note: It will appear as though you have chosen 9 courses in myBlueprint, as Civics (CHV205) and Careers (GLC205) are two **HALF CREDITS** that must be selected as two separate course codes.
- Alternates:
 - 2 courses – this is **MANDATORY**
 - There are no guarantees of your optional courses being available
- Music Repertoire Selections:
 - BAND AMR20C
 - CHOIR AMR20W

- In the “**Student Comment**” section of the registration/confirmation page in myBlueprint, let your counsellor know what course you will register for in summer school.
- If you are not sure about summer school, register for the course at Oakridge for next year.

MYBLUEPRINT REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Log into: **myblueprint.ca/tvdsb**
- Username: first 4 letters of last name, first 4 letter of first name, last 3 digits of student number @ **gotvdsb.ca**
 - **Example: John Smith with student number 123.456.789:**
smitjohn789@gotvdsb.ca
- Password: use your “gotvdsb.ca” account password used to log into your school computer.
